An Comhdhail – CLASS RULES

COMPLUSORY RULES

1. Right of Refusal for entry into The Claddagh Irish Dance School of Dancing is retained by the teacher(s) of The Claddagh Irish Dance School of Dancing.
2. All dancers must register with their Dancing School each year.
3. Students must show respect & courtesy towards their teacher(s) & fellow students.
4. Dancers must seek permission to leave the hall centre.
5. Dancers must seek permission to perform in any event/display/concert which is dance related.
6. All dancers while in class or attending a dancing event must behave in a respectful and disciplined manner.
7. Any dancer on medication or suffering from a medical condition /learning difficulties must inform their teacher(s) on joining the class.
8. Dancers should be dropped to & collected from class at designated times.
9. Chewing Gum is absolutely forbidden.
10. Dancers must inform their teacher(s) when they wish to cease classes.
11. Rules are not negotiable.

EXPLANATIONS OF THE ABOVE:

1. The teacher has the right to refuse entry to
 - (a) a new pupil
 - (b) A pupil from another class within An Comhdhail
 - (c) A pupil from another class outside of An Comhdhail
 - (d) A pupil from within the class.
2. Registration — (a) The teacher has an up-to-date listing, (b) Class rules can be issued each year and therefore each dancer is aware of any changes.
3. Respect & Courtesy are expected in class.
4. Permission is sought to leave the hall for e.g. to go to the toilet or when being collected so that the teacher is aware of where the students are at all times.
5. Permission is sought for performances so that the teacher is
 - (a) Aware of the venue/environment - is it safe?
 - (b) Aware that their material is being performed.
 - (c) is happy to support the event/ be associated with the event.
6. Dancers are aware that good behaviour is expected at all times and their behaviour outside of class is as important as in class.
7. Teachers must be made aware on the day of joining so that proper arrangements are made with regard to medication/ contacts
8. Parents must be conscious that teachers are responsible for class times and once class is finished responsibility reverts to parents. Dancers will also miss out on valuable class time (steps/warm up excercises) by being late.
9. Owing to the direct experience of at least 2 teachers this rule is compulsory.
10. Informing the teacher re cessation of classes is (a) for good manners & (b) time to contemplate.
11. All rules apply.
